**ORDINANCE TO AMEND RESOLUTION CM-11-28
A REVISED ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE
WITH JOB CLASSIFICATIONS BY TITLE, STAFF LEVELS,
AND ASSIGNED PAY GRADES WITH RANGES**

WHEREAS, The Municipal Manager has recommended a revised organizational structure and a Compensation Plan; and

WHEREAS, Council has reviewed the proposed plan and wishes to implement the changes as recommended by the Manager;

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Municipality of West Milton, Ohio that:

SECTION I: The following revised organizational listing showing position classification titles, staffing levels, and pay grade assignments is hereby established for the full-time employees of the Municipality of West Milton.

SECTION IV: A Career Plan Advancement for employees assigned to the classification of Maintenance Worker I is hereby established by which said employee's shall be eligible to have their position reallocated to Maintenance Worker II upon the completion of three full years of service in the Maintenance Worker I class and certification by their Supervisor that said employee can operate all equipment and is knowledgeable in all areas of Street Division operations. Employees appointed to the classification of Plant Operator shall have a (I) designation and be assigned to Pay Grade 10 until such time they have obtained all the certifications required in the Job Description for the position. Employees so advanced may receive a pay increase not to exceed 5% as determined by the Municipal Manager upon reallocation of their classification.

SECTION V: A Career Plan Advancement for newly hired police officers hereby establishes that said officers shall hire in at Pay Grade 11, and serve a probationary period of one year. Upon completion, there shall be a period of five continuous years of incremental or "step" increases. Five successive years shall mean employment years two (2) through (6). Each increment shall be implemented on the anniversary date of employment. See attached schedule.

SECTION VI: The Career Advancement Plan delineated in Section V shall apply to officers currently on staff who have service totaling five (5) years or less.

SECTION VII: The Municipal Manager is hereby authorized to issue regulations and implement policies for the administration of the Classification Plan as set forth in this Resolution.

SECTION VIII: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law and all other ordinances or resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are hereby rescinded.
