

RESOLUTION CM-14-09

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING STATE ISSUE 1, RENEWAL OF THE STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM, ON THE MAY 6TH, 2014 BALLOT.

WHEREAS, Ohio local communities are in continuing need of support for vital road, bridge, sewer, water and other infrastructure projects; and

WHEREAS, Ohio has in place a state program of support for local communities which not only helps to fund infrastructure projects, but also creates large numbers of construction and allied jobs; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio State Capital Improvement Program has successfully provided support for more than 11,500 such projects and resulting job creation since its inception in 1987; and

WHEREAS, Issue 1 on the May 6, 2014 statewide ballot will authorize the State of Ohio to issue up to \$1.875 billion in capital improvement bonds to pay for, or help local governments pay for the cost of public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, no new taxes are required to fund repayment of the bonds.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST MILTON HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section I: That the Council for the West Milton supports and endorses the passage of State Issue 1 (renewal of the Ohio Public Works Commission Program) and that a copy of this Resolution be addressed to Strong Ohio Communities.

Section II: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
