**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2014

WHEREAS, Council by Ordinance CM-13-28 adopted 2014 final appropriations for the various funds utilized by the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust the appropriations to reflect unanticipated expenditures,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Municipality of West Milton, that:

SECTION I: The following amendments to the 2014 appropriations of the Municipality of West Milton, Ohio are hereby made.
