

RESOLUTION CM-15-05

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A POLICE VEHICLE FOR THE WEST MILTON POLICE DIVISION

WHEREAS, the Municipality's 2015 operating budget includes \$32,500 for the purchase of a new police vehicle for the current calendar year and funds have been duly appropriated; and

WHEREAS, Council by Resolution CM-96-21 authorized the Municipality's participation in the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, Key Chrysler of Xenia, Ohio is the local state bid dealer for 2015.

WHEREAS, it is further the opinion of the Manager that this action by the Council is in the best interest of the Municipality and in compliance with the Administrative Code and Resolution CM-96-21.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Council of the Municipality of West Milton, Ohio that:

SECTION I: The Municipal Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase a model year 2015 Dodge Charger with the police package in the amount of \$25,119.00 and to execute all documents and agreements necessary to complete the transaction of this purchase.

SECTION II: The Municipal Manager is hereby authorized to have the vehicle properly changed over with the necessary police equipment through Camp Safety Equipment Inc. of Cincinnati, Ohio in the amount of \$8,211.36.
